

We see quite a lot of this setup to show us what a good, responsible breeder should be doing, how the pups should be reared and socialised, how good homes are ready to take the pups so they will not be going to a pet shop or anything. But the family has a small house, a shepherd is a big dog, and all these pups are taken anyway, as
