

They have terrific pictures (which the kids love), and many elements of a non-fiction text, such as labeling, comparisons, captions, glossary, types of print, etc. I would highly recommend this book - really all of the time for kids books - to those looking for appropriate non-fiction books for a first grade classroom. The level 1 and 2 books are most appropriate.
